Board of Managers' January Meeting Highlights

The Board of Managers discussed and took action on several items at their January 2017 meeting. First, the board unanimously adopted the CCPN Mission and Vision Statements (see above).

The board also was updated

on recruitment activities including letters, which have been sent to independent physicians who currently are not part of CCPN, and the active recruitment of psychiatrists and ob-gyns. Dr. Dobson briefed board members on the new joint venture between

Centene and the North Carolina Community Health Center Association.

In other business, the board received committee updates and extended the deadline for the Practice Survey. The Board of Managers' February 2017 meeting will be a face-to-face meeting on February 2.

Meet Larry Mann, MD, CCPN Board of Managers

As a member of CCPN Board of Managers, I hope to be an advocate for both providers and patients. Having done primary care for 30 years, I want to help CCPN develop solutions that work for primary care, mental health care, specialists, hospitals and other ancillary services.

CCPN's goal is quality, cost-effective health care for patients. Providers instinctively know what quality of care is and need to have input in developing a new model of care. Collaboration between primary care, mental health providers, and specialists to improve efficiency and cost is what we are after with CCPN's work. CCPN is able to build on solid groundwork that CCNC has laid, so we are starting with strong momentum.

In the future, medical decisions need to be data driven, quality driven, outcome driven and cost driven. All of these factors need to be considered by providers and insurers to deliver high-quality and high-value care.

So, as we move forward, we must consider

using accurate data and care management of chronic and complicated conditions. The primary care physician office and medical home

needs to be in the center of a patient's care to coordinate patient treatment strategies and collaborate with specialists, hospitals and community resources. Blood tests and radiology studies should not be duplicated or done unnecessarily. We need to focus on policies to prevent unnecessary, expensive ER visits. Good communication between specialists, hospitals and primary care providers also will lead to better care for our patients. That is our goal.

The future will not look like the present or past. I envision mental health providers embedded in primary care offices -- telecommunication bringing special-



ist expertise directly to patient care -- and care managers embedded in practices to assist in improving care for patients with chronic or complicated conditions. The last point is critical -- Care Managers can assist providers and patients access the full range of health care including specialists, hospitals, mental health providers and community resources more efficiently to address important underlying social determinants of health.

The true key to making this new paradigm work will be collaboration. Developing practice guidelines and protocols, and most important, creating fair reimbursement models is critical for maintaining best practices. All of this is what CCPN is working on collaboratively. We need to work together to make this a positive change for practices, patients and our medical communities.

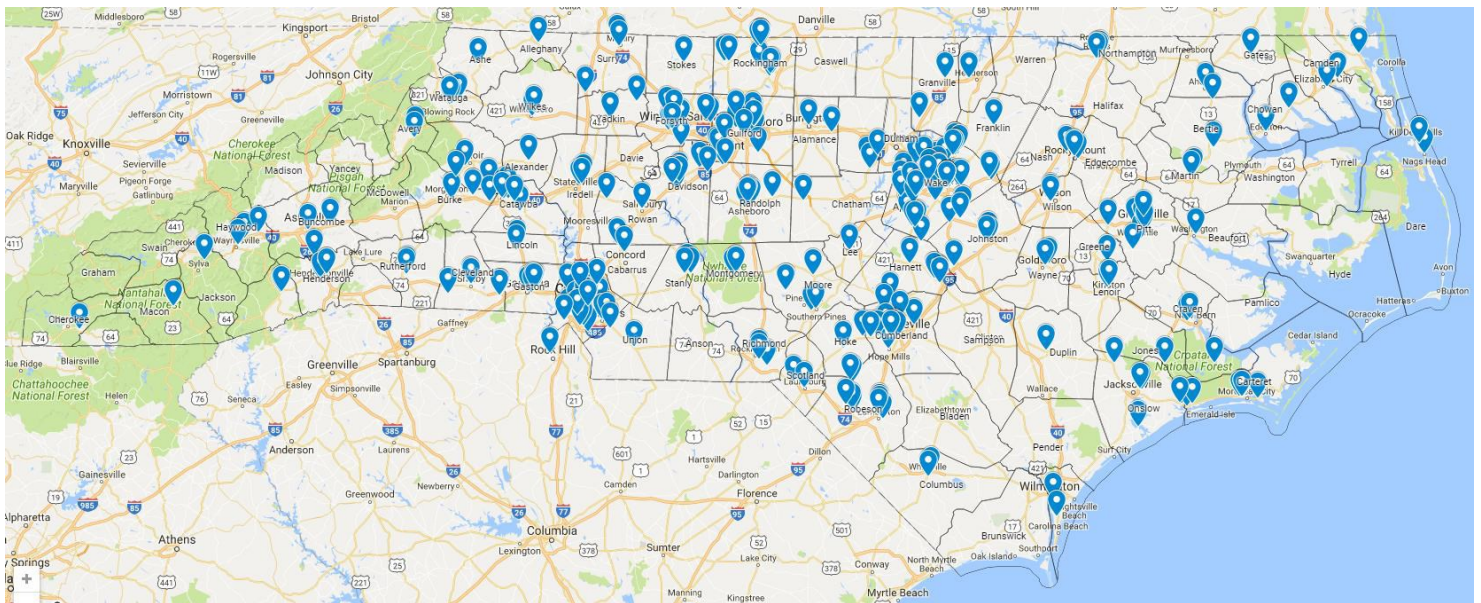
