### What is CCPN?

Community Care Physician Network (CCPN) is an organization committed to helping independent practices remain financially viable, supporting high-quality care, maximizing satisfaction with the practice of medicine, and keeping control of healthcare in the hands of community-based physicians.

- CCPN Clinicians: 3,815

### CCPN Practice Characteristics

CCPN is comprised of over **3,815 clinicians** who have joined together to create an organization where practices can thrive in the changing healthcare payment reform environment.

The majority of CCPN clinicians are focused on family medicine, pediatrics, or internal medicine.

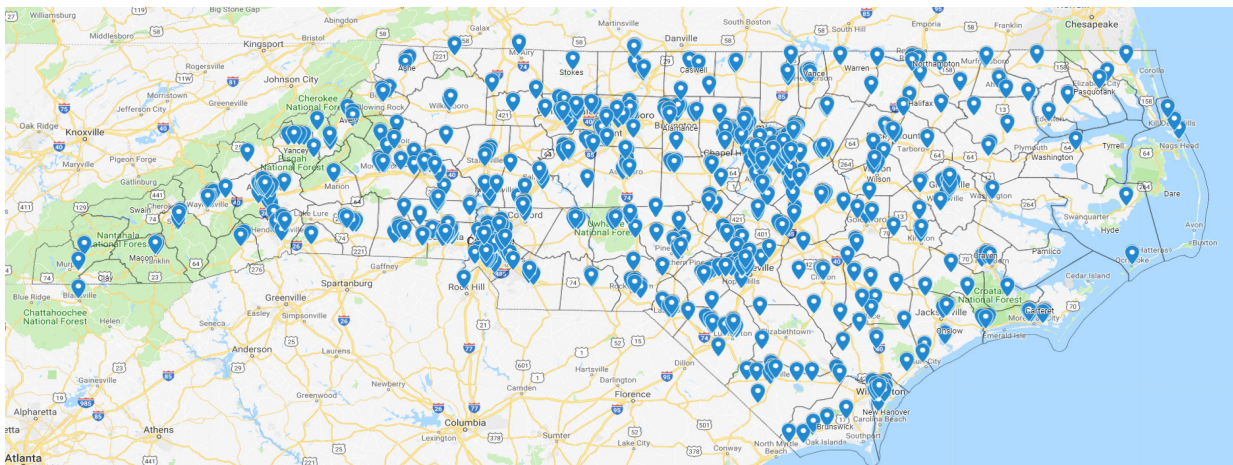
Other enrolled clinicians include local health departments, psychiatrists, psychologists, and OB-GYNs.

#### CCPN Practice Specialties

- Family Medicine: 44%
- Pediatrics: 18%
- Behavioral Health: 15%
- School-based/Student Care: 6%
- Adult: 5%
- Women's Health: 4%
- OB-GYN: 3%

#### CCPN Clinician Specialties

- Family Medicine: 35%
- Psychiatry/Behavioral Health: 25%
- Pediatrics: 20%
- Internal Medicine: 13%
- OB-GYN: 4%
