Who is CCPN?

Community Care Physician Network (CCPN) is a clinically integrated network committed to improving the quality of care and support for North Carolina's independent clinicians as the state's health care delivery system transitions to value-based care.

With more than 3,600 primary care physicians in over 1,000 practices, CCPN is North Carolina's largest independent network.

CCPN's Board of Managers and Co-Presidents are physicians who work in independent practices from the mountains to the coast. They understand the values and needs of independent clinicians across NC.

What does CCPN do for my practice?

CCPN is led by practicing behavioral health and primary care clinicians from across North Carolina who understand the value that behavioral health clinicians bring to patient care.

CCPN is committed to providing behavioral health clinicians with:

- Support and services needed to remain independent
- Access to data demonstrating the quality and value of behavioral health services
- Tools to develop clinical improvement initiatives and establish quality metrics
- The opportunity to contract with private and public payers seeking a high-performing network
- Ways to promote collaboration between behavioral health and primary care
- New opportunities to participate in quality improvement and value-based payment pilot initiatives with payers

How CCPN Works

Governance

CCPN is governed by a board composed of participating clinicians, ensuring that CCPN operates in the best interests of practices and patients.

Value

Through CCPN, independent practices can collect quality and cost data that demonstrates value to both public and private payers. Practices are able to consider participation in contracts with payers, employers, and other health care entities.

Quality Improvement

Participating clinicians serve on CCPN's Quality Improvement Committee, which develops clinical improvement initiatives and establishes quality goals.

Non-Exclusive Model

CCPN is an open, non-exclusive network. It seeks to collaborate rather than to compete, offering prospective provider-led entities (PLEs), managed care organizations (MCOs), and other payers all-insurers access to an extended, high-functioning primary care and behavioral health infrastructure with value-added specialty services. An insurer seeking to ensure patient access across a rural area, for example, may do so quickly and cost-effectively through a contract with CCPN. CCPN will look for opportunities to collaborate with other programs demonstrating aligned quality and cost-effectiveness goals.

Joining Fee

For practices with fewer than 15 clinicians, there is a one-time enrollment fee of \$75 per clinician. For practices or IPAs with more than 15 clinicians, the one-time enrollment fee is \$50 per clinician.
